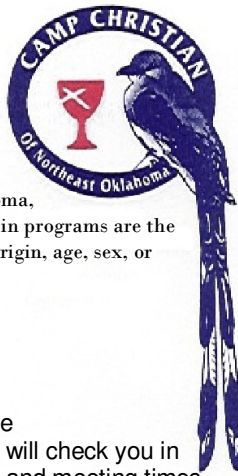


Camp Christian

Camp Policies

Please make a copy of these policies available to each member of your group

2009 / 2010

Arrival:

- Groups must arrive at the agreed upon time
- Soon after your arrival, the camp manager will check you in and confirm your schedule, meals, activities, and meeting times.
- Please have a copy of your schedule to provide to camp staff.
- At check in, you must provide the camp manager with the number of people in your group (this includes leaders, sponsors, campers, youth and children)

Departure:

- Payments are due in full upon departure, no exceptions
- Be sure to bring a check. You might want to bring an extra in case you make an error.
- Please have all group members off campus by the agreed upon time. Another group may be arriving shortly after your departure time.

Parking:

- Vehicles should be parked in designated parking areas except when loading/unloading
- Do not block the road or entrance at any time

Supervision:

- Camp Christian expects adult supervision of all group members and activities at all times. This includes supervision during swim times and meals.

Security:

- Camp Christian does not provide security. The entrance gate will be locked at 10:00 pm daily unless other arrangements are made.

Pool:

- No swimming allowed without Camp Christian life guards
- Scheduled swim times are to be between 9:00 am and 6:00 pm unless other arrangements are made.
- Camp Christian will provide Life Guard personnel to supervise each scheduled swim; however, group sponsors must be present to assist when their group is using the pool.
- For large groups, a swim test may be given to each child/youth to determine their swimming abilities. Each child/youth will be given a wrist band indicating their swimming level. Less accomplished swimmers may be restricted to the shallow end of the pool.
- Instructions from Life Guards or Camp Christian Staff are final. Failure to follow instructions may result in individuals or the entire group losing their swimming privilege.
- No food or drinks allowed inside the fenced area of the pool.
- Absolutely no swimming in Brushy Creek or Grand River

First Aid:

- Each group is responsible for their own First Aid, emergency care, and emergency transportation
- Camp Christian has limited supplies of basic first aid items which can be made available to groups
- Groups are responsible for any supplies or equipment beyond that which is available
- Local First Responders and EMT Personnel are familiar with Camp Christians location

General Rules:

- No alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, firearms, or fireworks are allowed on camp property at any time
- No pets are allowed on camp property at any time
- Smoking is not allowed on the grounds without prior notification. Smoking in the buildings is prohibited at all times and will result in a \$100.00 fine per incident
- Graffiti will not be tolerated. Your group will be charged \$50.00 per square inch for graffiti. This includes magic/permanent markers, paint, pens, carving, or defacing walls, ceilings, bunk beds, mattresses, tables, trees, or any camp property. Exceptions are sidewalk chalk, or designated graffiti boards
- All groups are required to clean the facilities they use. This includes taking out the trash, vacuuming, sweeping, mopping, cleaning kitchen facilities, and removing all personal items. Failure to clean the facilities will result in loss of deposit. Cleaning supplies will be provided
- Groups are not allowed to use camp phones unless it's an emergency. Camp Christian encourages limited use of cell phones, and prefers they not be used at all, especially by youth/children. Cell Phone coverage in the area is limited
- All persons must wear shoes at all times except in the pool area. Camp Christian requires closed-toe shoes, not open-toe sandals, be worn for safety. Sandals may be worn to and from the pool and bath houses
- Food and Drinks are NOT permitted in the cabins or dorms at any time. Food attracts insects, rodents, and other pests
- Camp Christian Staff may enter any facility at any time to inspect the premises, observe group activities, provide maintenance of the facility, as well as any other reasonable purpose
- Because of fire hazards, NO campfires or fires of any nature are permitted at Camp Christian except scheduled fires in designated areas supervised by Camp Christian Staff
- No equipment (including beds, mattresses, chairs, tables, etc.) may be removed from any building unless approved by Camp Christian Staff
- Unsupervised activities outside of the main camp area are prohibited due to the dangers that are present in nature.
- Only God can create a tree, so none are to be defaced or cut down
- All profanity, immoral conduct of any nature, and immodest dress is forbidden at Camp Christian
- Males and Females may NOT visit each others dorms or cabins at any time
- Any activity that could cause injury to a fellow camper or damage to camp property is prohibited
- Hazing, bullying, or giving another camper a hard time by any group or individual will NOT be tolerated
- All personal items left at Camp Christian will be placed in the Lost & Found box and held for 30 days. Owners of lost items are responsible for shipping charges if they want items returned
- Please help conserve energy by turning off all lights and fans when not needed
- Camp Christian recommends everyone walking after dark use a flashlight. (Flashlights are not provided by Camp Christian)
- Camp Christian reserves the right to expel any individual or group not willing to comply with these Rules and Guidelines at any time. This includes individual members of groups or entire groups. No refunds will be given for expelled individuals or groups
